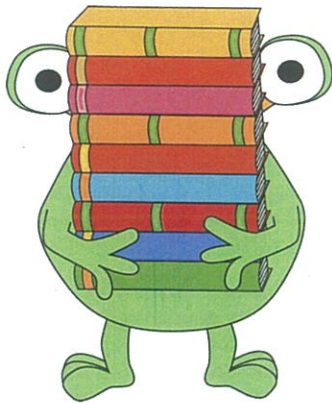
Entry forms for Tahuna's got Talent - 60 seconds to fame are in the office, heats are on Monday 9th December in the Muritai Centre at lunchtime.

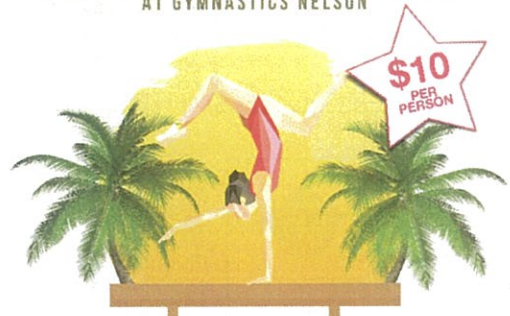
Library stocktake is happening this week, please make sure you have returned ALL Tahunanui School library books. Invoices for books not returned will be sent next week.
