



WASH YOUR HANDS



With the increase in cases of covid19 in New Zealand it is important that we ensure we are vigilant with personal hygiene.

Ministry of Health's advice on keeping ourselves healthy focuses on correct hand washing. This is especially important for children.

Wet your hands, apply soap and thoroughly spread the soap around your hands for 20 seconds, then rinse. Dry well with a paper towel.


It is important to wash your hands after going to the toilet, after coughing or sneezing or blowing your nose and before eating or handling food.


Tuatara Award
